Introduction

With an ever-increasing number of states legalizing the use of cannabis (some requiring a doctor's prescription, others including for recreation), the buyer is faced with the question, "Which strain is going to give me the best results?"

This book is designed to answer that question and is in a format allowing the reader to carry it into a dispensary for a quick check of what can be expected with any given strain available therein. However, browsing through it, one is likely to find a good number of strains they want to experience over time and keep an eye out for.

While there are literally thousands of strains, there are the classics and there are the most recent and popular (both of which are likely to be available at any given dispensary).

This book will provide the reader with key information, such as:

- Sativa/Indica ratio (Sativa increases mental focus and even energizes, producing a "high" while indica strains sedate, relax the body, and impart a feeling of being "stoned." Hybrids attempt to provide the best of both.)
- THC levels: How strong is it?
- CBD levels: A key factor in many of the medicinal benefits
- Possible side effects: From Euphoria to Dry Mouth to Anxiety, and the percentage of people who experience them
- Medicinal benefits and the percentage of effectiveness in each category
- Taste and smell
- Growing information, such as flowering time, yield, and special needs

This and much more—for each strain.

Here is how to interpret listing for uses for medicinal and

recreational, as well as any potential side effects:

- (ExH) 100% of users experience this effect to a very significant degree
- (VH) 80 to 90% of users experience this very strong effect
- (MH or HM) 70% of users experience this significant effect
- (M) 40 to 60% of users experience this very noticeable effect
- (LM or ML) 30% of users experience this usually mild effect
- (VL) 5 to 20% of users experience this mild effect
- (ExL) < 5% of users experience this usually very mild effect

Note that some effects may be listed without percentages. This is because that information was not available, it was worthwhile to include those terms for potential users.

Strain: Acapulco Gold

Dominance: 100% sativa (Landrace, Mexico)

Parent Plants: Landrace

Grower: Wherever you can find it, but some “crosses” are out there
(*not Ac. Gd.*)

Awards: *High Times* Cannabis Cup winner (sativa, 2010)

THC: 20–22%

CBD: Not reported

Flowering: 11 weeks

Yield: Medium

Potential Positive Effects: Euphoria (H), Pleasant (H), Relaxation (H)

Potential Negative Effects: Paranoia (VL)

Reported Treatment Uses: Alzheimer’s (H), Pain (H), Spasms (H)

Description: One of the most popular strains of all time.

Growing Hints: Typical of sativas, the plant is a tall, robust grower.

Additional Notes: Beware some selling a cross they call by same name—make sure to get Landrace!



Strain: ACDC

Dominance: 50/50 (sativa dominant)

Parent Plants: Canatonic x Cannabis ruderalis

Grower: Resin Seeds

Awards: Numerous Cannabis Cup awards

THC: 1/20th of the CBD level

CBD: 19–56.9%

Flowering: Auto flowering

Yield: Up to 14 oz/m² indoors; around the same per plant outdoors

Potential Positive Effects: Uplifting (H)

Potential Negative Effects: Dry Mouth (ExH)

Reported Treatment Uses: Pain (H), Stress (H), Anxiety (H), Epileptic Seizures (H), Cancer (H), MS (H)

Description: Smell is a pleasant sweet citrus with earthy undertones. Taste is a pleasant mix of sweet, peppery pine with an aftertaste of skunkiness.

Growing Hints: Bushy, up to 4 feet, needs support when it begins to bud. Likes minerals, especially magnesium and calcium.

Additional Notes: Very rare in that it is useful to patients suffering from a very wide array of diseases. Offers a whole-body relaxation, combined with mental focus. Fantastic medicinal strain that allows you to function fine mentally, since the THC is low. An extremely wide array of illnesses respond profoundly to ACDC. One woman who has ongoing pain from fibromyalgia wrote, “Thank God! After five puffs I was pain free for the first time in eighteen years.” Great any time.

(a.k.a. Bull Rider)

Dominance: 100% indica

Parent Plants: Afggabu Kabdrace

Grower: West Coast Trading Co.

Awards: N/A

THC: 15–25%

CBD: 2%

Flowering: Not given, but outside matures in late October, early November

Yield: Has Good to High yields, whether indoors or outdoors

Potential Positive Effects: Relaxation (VH), Hungry (H), Euphoria (H)

Potential Negative Effects: Dry Mouth (VH), Anxiety (M), Paranoia (L), Dry Eyes (VL)

Reported Treatment Uses: Stress (VH), Pain (H), Insomnia (H), Muscle Spasms (MH), Depression (M)

Description: A beautiful, relatively short plant.

Growing Hints: Likes a Mediterranean climate, but should do well in heat.

Additional Notes: Developed by a Bull Rider in San Diego (specifically, Ocean Beach).





Strain: African

Dominance: 100% sativa (Landrace, Africa)

Parent Plants: Landrace

Grower: Unknown

Awards: N/A

THC: Not listed, but very strong

CBD: Not reported

Flowering: Typical sativa, so likely 11 weeks or more

Yield: Not reported

Potential Positive Effects: Euphoria (H), Happiness (H)

Potential Negative Effects: Dry Eyes (M)

Reported Treatment Uses: AIDS (H), Increased Energy (H),
Depression (H), Appetite (H)

Description: Very strong. Various landrace crosses in Africa.
Excellent reputation.

Growing Hints: None have been published but, as a sativa, you
can expect it to be tall.

Additional Notes: Note lack of negative side effects. However, it is
very strong!



Strain: AK-47

Dominance: 65/35 (sativa dominant)

Parent Plants: Columbian x Mexican x Thai x Afghani

Grower: Serious Seeds

Awards: Winner of no less than 16 awards, including: Barcelona High Life Cup winner (hash, 2005); Toronto Treating Yourself Expo winner (sativa, 2011); *High Times* Cannabis Cup, third place (hybrid, 2011)

THC: 13–20%

CBD: 1%

Flowering: 8 to 9 weeks

Yield: High

Potential Positive Effects: Happiness (H), Euphoria (H), Uplifting (H), Relaxation (MH), Creativity (MH)

Potential Negative Effects: Dry Mouth (H), Dry Eyes (M), Dizziness (L), Paranoia (L), Headache (ExL)

Reported Treatment Uses: Stress (H), Anxiety (MH), Pain (MH), Depression (M), Insomnia (ML)

Description: Smell is sour and earthy. Taste has a hint of sweet flowers.

Growing Hints: Easy grow indoors or out.

Additional Notes: Hits quickly and with power like the weapon after which it is named. However, most report a mellow feeling accompanied by mental focus and creativity.





Strain: Alaskan Thunderfuck

(a.k.a. ATF, Matanuska Thunderfuck, Matanuska Tundra)

Dominance: Percent not available (sativa-dominant cross)

Parent Plants: (Unknown x No. Cal. x Russian ruderalis) x Unknown Afghani

Grower: Unk.

Awards: 2011 Cannabis Cup winner (2011); *Rolling Stone* Best 5 Strains of 2017

THC: 16–23%

CBD: Not reported

Flowering: 12 weeks

Yield: 350g/m² indoors. Outdoors depends on cultivation practices

Potential Positive Effects: Uplifting, Relaxation

Potential Negative Effects: Dry Mouth (H), Dry Eyes (M), Dizziness (VL), Paranoia (VL), Anxiety (VL)

Reported Treatment Uses: PTSD (H), Chronic Pain (H), Increased Energy (M)

Description: Very strong smell—like pine, menthol, lemon, and skunk. Tastes like banana and orange with a spicy chocolate aftertaste.

Growing Hints: Very easy grow but requires space and support of colas. Prone to mold and mildew.

Additional Notes: Clear-headed, creative, and productive.





Strain: Amnesia Haze

Dominance: 80/20 (sativa dominant)

Parent Plants: South Asian Landrace x Jamaican Landrace

Grower: Difficult to find in US, extremely popular in Amsterdam

Awards: Cannabis Cup winner (sativa, 2004); Cannabis Cup winner (2012)

THC: 20–22%

CBD: 1%

Flowering: 12 weeks

Yield: 650g/m² indoors; 700g/plant outdoors

Potential Positive Effects: Relaxation, but not sleepiness (H), Happiness (H)

Potential Negative Effects: Dry Mouth (M), Dry Eyes (M), Dizziness (L), Paranoia (VL), Headache (VL)

Reported Treatment Uses: PTSD (H), Autism (H), ADHD (H), Migraines (H)

Description: Has the taste of earthy lemony citrus and smells earthy and peppery.

Growing Hints: None published.

Additional Notes: Very popular strain.





Strain: Apollo 13

Dominance: 85/15 (sativa dominant)

Parent Plants: P75 x Genius

Grower: Brothers Grimm

Awards: N/A

THC: 9%

CBD: Not reported

Flowering: 7 to 8 weeks

Yield: Heavy

Potential Positive Effects: Uplifting, Motivation, Happiness

Potential Negative Effects: Headache (H), Dry Mouth (M), Dry Eyes (L), Dizziness (L), Paranoia (L)

Reported Treatment Uses: Social Anxiety (H), Depression (H), Stress (H), Pain (H), Motivation (H), Creativity (H), Increased Energy (M)

Description: Tastes like herbal tea and skunk.

Growing Hints: Easy to grow, even for beginners.

Additional Notes: Hard to find but easy to grow for first timers. Moderate THC good for first-time users. Drinking lots of water is recommended.





Strain: Aurora Indica

Dominance: 90/10 (indica dominant)

Parent Plants: Northern Lights x Afghani

Grower: Nirvana Seeds

Awards: None listed

THC: 14–19%

CBD: 0.1%

Flowering: 9 to 11 weeks

Yield: 10 to 14 oz/m² indoors; 14 oz/plant outdoors

Potential Positive Effects: Relaxation (ExH), Sleepiness (H), Happiness (MH), Euphoria (MH), Uplifting (L)

Potential Negative Effects: Dry Mouth (ExH), Dry Eyes (L), Paranoia (VL)

Reported Treatment Uses: Pain (ExH), Stress (ExH), Insomnia (H), Muscle Spasms (MH), Depression (MH), ADHD (H)

Description: Smells like sweet earthy mango with a bit of lavender. Tastes like earthy, spicy mango with a sweet exhale.

Growing Hints: None available.

Additional Notes: Even though the THC levels are not super high, it is a powerful smoke. Couchlock is common with this strain.





Strain: Auto Critical Orange Punch

Dominance: 70/30 (indica dominant)

Parent Plants: Kritical Bilbo XXL (auto flowering—ruderalis) x
Orange Punch

Grower: Dutch Passion

Awards: *High Times* Top 10 Strains of 2018

THC: Medium to Potent

CBD: Not reported

Flowering: 10 to 11 weeks

Yield: 450g/m² indoors; outdoors 90g/plant

Potential Positive Effects: Euphoria, Happiness, Peaceful, Mental
Clarity

Potential Negative Effects: Not given

Reported Treatment Uses: Stress (H)

Description: Tastes and smells like hashish, skunk, and citrus.

Growing Hints: 2 to 3 feet high, auto flowering. Does well indoors
or outdoors, in almost any climate. Colas may need support.
Give plenty of room for roots. Easy grow.

Additional Notes: Extremely popular. Balances a relaxed body and
clear mind. Good day or night.





Strain: Bangi Haze

Dominance: 70/30 (sativa dominant)

Parent Plants: F8 stabilized Congolese x Nepalese Landraces

Grower: Ace Seeds

Awards: N/A

THC: 10–15%

CBD: 0.25%

Flowering: 11 weeks

Yield: 21oz/m² indoors; 40oz/plant outdoors

Potential Positive Effects: Energetic (H), Hungry (H), Focused (H), Euphoria (L to H)

Potential Negative Effects: Dry Mouth (H), Dry Eyes (L), Paranoia (M)

Reported Treatment Uses: Stress (M), Pain (ML), Depression (VH), Insomnia (ML)

Description: Smells very sweet as well, with earthy berries, pungent herbal spices, and cheese. Tastes like berries and bananas with a hint of honey and cheese.

Growing Hints: Strongly resistant to both cold and mold.
Likes a sunny, dry climate.

Additional Notes: When growing, the flower smells like floral lemon and anise.





Strain: BC Big Bud

Dominance: 65/35 (sativa dominant)

Parent Plants: Big Bud x Unknown sativa strains

Grower: Parent plants vary among breeders

Awards: N/A

THC: 12–16%

CBD: 0.18–0.51%

Flowering: 8 to 9 weeks

Yield: Huge and Colossal have been terms used for this strain.

Noted for giant buds and huge yields

Potential Positive Effects: Relaxation (M), Mellow (M)

Potential Negative Effects: Dry Mouth (M), Dry Eyes (M-L),
Dizziness (L), Paranoia (VL), Anxiety (VL)

Reported Treatment Uses: Stress (H), Pain (MH), Depression
(MH), Appetite (MH), Insomnia (MH)

Description: Noted for pressure field around eyes and forehead
when effects first hit. Smells like skunky earth. Tastes like earth
and sweet berries.

Growing Hints: Support for massive buds is essential.

Additional Notes: A true day or night strain.





Strain: Black Widow

(a.k.a. White Widow)

NOTE: *This is in reference to the origins of the strain, as opposed to what most now call White Widow.*

Dominance: 70/30 (indica dominant)

Parent Plants: Brazilian Landrace sativa x South India Landrace indica (three different phenotypes)

Grower: Developed by Shantibaba when co-owner of Green House Seeds—now Mr. Nice

Awards: Cannabis Cup winner (best indica, 1995)

THC: 24%

CBD: Not reported

Flowering: 8 to 10 weeks

Yield: 350 to 450g/m² indoors; 300 to 400g/plant outdoors

Potential Positive Effects: Euphoria (MH), Happiness (MH), Relaxation (MH), Hungry (ML)

Potential Negative Effects: Dry Mouth (ML), Dry Eyes (ML), Dizziness (L), Paranoia, Headache (VL)

Reported Treatment Uses: Stress (M), Pain (M), Depression (ML), Insomnia (ML)

Description: Varies among the three different phenotypes.

Growing Hints: Considered difficult to grow.

Additional Notes: Hits hard and is long lasting.





Strain: Blackberry

Dominance: 50/50 hybrid cross

Parent Plants: Black Domina x Raspberry Cough

Grower: Nirvana Seeds

Awards: N/A

THC: 20–26%

CBD: <1%

Flowering: 9 to 11 weeks

Yield: Reported only as High

Potential Positive Effects: Relaxation (M), Happiness (M), Euphoria (M), Sleepiness (ML), Uplifting (ML)

Potential Negative Effects: Dry Mouth (ML), Dry Eyes (ML), Dizziness (VL), Paranoia (VL), Headache (ExL)

Reported Treatment Uses: Pain (M), Stress (M), Anxiety (M), Insomnia (ML), Depression (ML)

Description: Has a profoundly pungent smell during growth. Taste is fruity and earthy.

Growing Hints: Requires strong ventilation and filtering when grown indoors, due to smell.

Additional Notes: Very strong. Small dosage recommended.





Strain: Blue Bastard

Dominance: 70/30 (indica dominant)

Parent Plants: DJ Short Blueberry x God Bud x White Widow

Grower: Unk

Awards: N/A

THC: 18–23%

CBD: 0%

Flowering: Not reported

Yield: High

Potential Positive Effects: Euphoria (ExH), Happiness (ExH)

Potential Negative Effects: Dry Mouth (M), Dry Eyes (M),
Dizziness (M), Paranoia (M), Headache (M)

Reported Treatment Uses: Insomnia (H), Pain (MH), Stress (ExH),
Arthritis (L), Alzheimer's (MH)

Description: Smells and tastes like pungent blueberries with the
flavor of pine on the exhale.

Growing Hints: Not reported.

Additional Notes: “Hits like a truck . . . melt into whatever you are
sitting on.” Totally relaxed yet sociable/talkative and can be
mobile. Giggles.





Strain: Blue Dragon

Dominance: 60/40 (indica dominant)

Parent Plants: Blueberry x Sour Diesel

Grower: Origins shrouded in secrecy, but feminized seeds can be purchased from Pacific Seed Bank

Awards: N/A

THC: Up to over 24%

CBD: 1%

Flowering: 8 to 10 weeks

Yield: 1 lb/m² indoors; up to 19 oz/plant outdoors

Potential Positive Effects: Euphoria (VH), Happiness (VH), Relaxation (VH), Hungry (L)

Potential Negative Effects: Dry Mouth (ExH), Dry Eyes (M), Dizziness (VL), Paranoia (VL), Anxiety (ExL)

Reported Treatment Uses: Stress (ExH), Pain (VH), Insomnia (H), Appetite (M), Headaches (M)

Description: Tastes and smells like fuel and sweet berries.

Growing Hints: Resistant to powdery mildew and common diseases. Tall plant.

Additional Notes: Increasing in popularity due to medicinal effects. Very infrequent negative effects. Very balanced in indica/sativa effects.





Strain: Blue Dream

Dominance: 60/40 (sativa dominant)

Note: Some list as a 80/20 sativa dominant, crossed with Blueberry x Silver Haze that has slightly lower THC and very little CBD

Parent Plants: Blueberry x Haze

Grower: Dark Heart Nursery

Awards: BDS Analytics lists as “The Most Popular Marijuana Strain”

THC: 17–24%

CBD: 2%

Flowering: 9 to 10 weeks

Yield: 21 oz/m² indoors; up to 2 lb/plant outdoors

Potential Positive Effects: Euphoria (H), Happiness (H), Relaxation (H), Creativity (M)

Potential Negative Effects: Dry Mouth (ML), Dry Eyes (ML), Paranoia (L), Dizziness (L), Anxiety (VL)

Reported Treatment Uses: Stress (M), Anxiety (M), Depression (M), Nausea (M), Pain (M–L), Insomnia (L)

Description: Smells and tastes like sweet, fresh blueberries.

Growing Hints: Hearty, easy to grow plant with high yield but vulnerable to spider mites.

Additional Notes: Full body relaxation and cerebral invigoration. Easy grow, widespread availability.





Strain: Blue Rhino

Dominance: 55/45 (indica dominant)

Parent Plants: Blueberry x White Rhino

Grower: DJ Short

Awards: N/A

THC: 15–20%

CBD: 2%

Flowering: 8 to 8.5 weeks

Yield: 500 to 600g/m² indoors; 500g/plant outdoors

Potential Positive Effects: Euphoria (ExH), Relaxation (VH), Sleepiness (H), Uplifting (M)

Potential Negative Effects: Dry Mouth (ExH), Dry Eyes (H), Headache (VL), Dizziness (VL), Anxiety (VL)

Reported Treatment Uses: Pain (ExH), Stress (ExH), Muscle Spasms (VH), Depression (H), Insomnia (H)

Description: Tastes and smells like a combination of earthy and sweet with a skunky hint to the smell.

Growing Hints: Not reported.

Additional Notes: Very balanced between a head and body high. Relaxed, but also focused.

Potential Negative Effects: Dry Mouth (H), Dry Eyes (VH), Dizziness (VL), Headache (VL), Anxiety (VL)

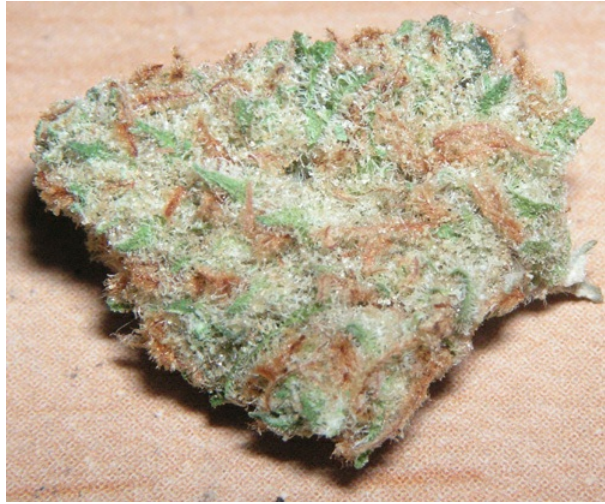

Potential Positive Effects: Increased Energy, Appetite

Potential Negative Effects: Anxiety (H), Couchlock (H)

Reported Treatment Uses: Shingles (H), Arthritis (H), MS (H),
Depression (H), Motivation (H)

Description: Tastes and smells like intense lemon with an earthy funk.

Growing Hints: Medium skill level required for a high yield.

Additional Notes: Not for beginners. A “one hit” strain. Not for those tending toward anxiety.

Parent Plants: Skunk x Northern Lights x Haze

Grower: Greenhouse Seeds (bred by Mr. Nice)

Awards: *High Times* Cannabis Cup winner (1997, 1998, 1999)

CBD: not reported

Flowering: 8 to 12 weeks

Yield: 30 to 130g/plant

Potential Positive Effects: Clarity, Creativity, Energetic

Potential Negative Effects: Dry Mouth (H), Dry Eyes (H)

Reported Treatment Uses: Stress (H), Fatigue (M), Relaxation (H)

Description: Tastes sweet and smells of fruity skunkiness.

Growing Hints: Tends to stretch—cut the center stalk for branching.

Additional Notes: People like this strain.



Strain: Tina

Dominance: 70/30 (indica dominant)

Parent Plants: Starbud x Unknown indica

Grower: Constantine x Triple OG (Generation F2)

Awards: *High Times* SoCal Harvest Cup winner (best indica, 2017)

THC: 19–22%

CBD: not available

Flowering: 9 weeks

Yield: Heavy producer

Potential Positive Effects: Euphoria (H), Relaxation (H), Sleepiness (MH)

Potential Negative Effects: Couchlock (H)

Reported Treatment Uses: Chronic Pain (VH), Cramps (H), Inflammation (M), Insomnia (MH),

Description: Smells like acrid jet fuel, earthy, spicy coffee. Tastes like super spicy chocolate with a heavy coffee flavor upon exhale.

Growing Hints: Definitely need to crop this one. Height is, medium tall. Indoors or outdoors OK.

Additional Notes: “Mother Nature’s Adderall” starts off with mental rush of enthusiasm, euphoria, and focus, which quickly turns into a sedative, deep relaxation, and eventual sleepiness. Known as the “Thunderdome of Indicas.”

Dominance: 80/20 (sativa dominant)

Parent Plants: Tai x Mexican x Afghani

Grower: Humboldt Seeds

Awards: Growers Cup third place (2009)

THC: 18–20%

CBD: 0.02–0.1%

Flowering: Not reported, but outside matures in late October to early November

Yield: 500g/m² indoors; 700g/plant outdoors

Potential Positive Effects: Euphoria (H), Relaxed (H), Creative (M)

Potential Negative Effects: Dry Mouth (H), Dry Eyes (H), Paranoia, Dizziness (L), Anxiety

Reported Treatment Uses: Stress (VH), Pain (H), Depression (H), PTSD (M), ADHD (M), Bipolar Disorder (M)

Description: Smells and tastes of spicy pine and sweet lemon.

Growing Hints: Tall plant wants warm/dry climate with no frost. High resistance to disease.

Additional Notes: Named in the 1970s by the men who had a train wreck near their grow and had to harvest prematurely to avoid detection.





Strain: White Widow

Dominance: 50/50 hybrid cross (Some list as 60/40 indica dominant)

Parent Plants: Indian Lavender x Columbian sativa

Grower: Dutch Passion

Awards: No formal awards listed but is considered a “staple” in Amsterdam coffeeshops

THC: 18–25%

CBD: 0.2%

Flowering: 8 to 9 weeks

Yield: 18 oz/m² indoors; 21 oz/plant outdoors

Potential Positive Effects: Euphoria (VH), Happiness (VH), Uplifting (H), Relaxation (H), Creativity (MH)

Potential Negative Effects: Dry Mouth (ExH), Dry Eyes (M), Paranoia (ML), Dizziness (ML), Headache (ExL)

Reported Treatment Uses: Stress (ExH), Depression (MH), Pain (MH), Fatigue (M), Insomnia (ML), Migraines, Social Anxiety, Bipolar Disorder

Description: Smells pungent, earthy, spicy, and herbal. Tastes earthy, woody, pungent, sweet, and sugary.

Growing Hints: Medium height. Likes it sunny but does fine in colder climates. Likes a SOG or SCROG setup. Easy grow. Resistant to diseases.

Additional Notes: Considered a “staple” in Amsterdam coffeeshops.
